- Supervisor Willis contacted Marchuska Brothers regarding the final work needing to be completed with the New Digital Sign Board prior to payment being made.

Town Clerk – Renny Zanker

- Clerk Zanker shared information regarding the courses she attended at the NYSTCA Conference in Albany.
- Clerk Zanker announced the new phone system is now in use. A short instructional class was given to those who were present at the time.
- Clerk Zanker stated the Broome County Clerk's Office has issued a time and date for the Passport Fair that will be held in August. Clerk Zanker thanked Missy and Nate Jackson from the Glen Aubrey Fire Station that were in attendance during the board meeting. The Fire Station granted the clerk use of the Fire Station for the Passport Fair that will be held in August.
- As August draws near the Broome County Clerk's Office will be in touch with the final details.

Code Enforcement Officer - Robert Wagner

- CEO Wagner provided the supervisor and councilmen with a monthly report as things have picked up this month, with 70 permits issued.
- CEO Wagner shared updates regarding the properties that were served with "Letters of Remedy."

- CEO Wagner announced the Whitney Point Legion will be celebrating a 100th Anniversary with a Community Block Party, to be held on Sunday, June 14, 2026 from 1:00 – 6:00 p.m. All are welcome!

Information Technologist – Rick Cicciarelli

- Mr. Cicciarelli stated locks are needed for the New Digital Sign Board. He has been working on the antenna that has to be installed prior to the software being in place for communicating from the Clerk's Office to the Digital Sign. Training of the new software to be held next week.
- Mr. Cicciarelli discussed concerns and what needs to be done yet with the Digital Sign.

Highway Superintendent – Bob Hoag

- Highway Superintendent Hoag reported he and his highway crew went to see the new truck to be sure it was set up properly before it is sent out to have the truck completed. Delivery will be sometime in October.
- Highway Superintendent Hoag stated the boom mower needs repairs. Crew is unable to mow until it is fixed. It was noted there was some concern as to the cost of repair. Supervisor Willis will discuss possible options for repair with Highway Superintendent.
- An 18" to 24" cross over pipe was replaced at the residence of Jim & Kelly Bushnell.
- Highway Superintendent Hoag asked the supervisor and councilmembers for permission to attend the Highway Conference in the fall. Supervisor Willis explained the advantages of sending Highway Superintendent Hoag to the Fall Conference. Supervisor Willis and the councilmembers agreed he should attend.
- Highway Superintendent Hoag purchased lime stone from a different vendor this year and was able to save the town \$9,000.
